This year ZONAMACO SALÓN DEL ANTICUARIO celebrates its third edition, and once again it will take place simultaneously with ZONAMACO FOTO, attracting national and international visitors.

The third edition of ZONAMACO SALÓN DEL ANTICUARIO will feature some of the most important antiquarians, both national and international, exhibiting decorative arts, jewelry, furniture, ceramics, clocks, lamps, silver, tapestries, textiles, manuscripts and other objects, all produced before 1960, as well as sculpture, painting and graphic arts dated before 1950. The selection committee is led by the antiquarians **Daniel Liebsohn** (Mexico City), **Mario Uvence** (Tuxtla Gutiérrez, Chiapas) and **Luis Alegria** (Portugal). The evaluation committee, in charge of overseeing the pieces exhibited at the fair, is conformed by **Juan Manuel Corrales** (Curator of the International Baroque Museum, Puebla), **Leonor Cortina** (President of the Casa la Bola Museum Patronage, Mexico City), **Héctor Rivero Borrell** (Director of the Franz Mayer Museum, Mexico City) and **Ottavio Fregia** (Co-director of Safra Antigüedades, Barcelona / Miami).
